We were blessed when we adopted our daughter Caroline almost 2 years ago and we now know the joy of being parents. It has been the best thing to ever happen to us. Caroline is truly the light of our lives. We would love to add another child to our family as we have plenty of love to give, so we are hoping for one more miracle.

Niall and I are a happily married couple, we first met in 1999 and were married 3 years later in 2002. We spend a lot of time doing things together and enjoy each other's company. We are best friends and have a mutual respect for each other. We live in Massachusetts, right outside of Boston. We love it here and feel like it's such a great place to live and raise a family. We are close to everything. Our house is only ten minutes from the ocean and we are only about 90 minutes from the mountains in New Hampshire. Downtown Boston has lots of museums and parks and a great aquarium. There is also a theater district and the circus and Disney on ice come to town every year. We also live only 2 miles from a wooded reservation area. They have a big playground and lots of trails and we go there regularly for walks.

Our house is a 2 level ranch home. It is very spacious and we have plenty of room for more additions to our family. Our house is on an acre of land and in back of us is a golf course. 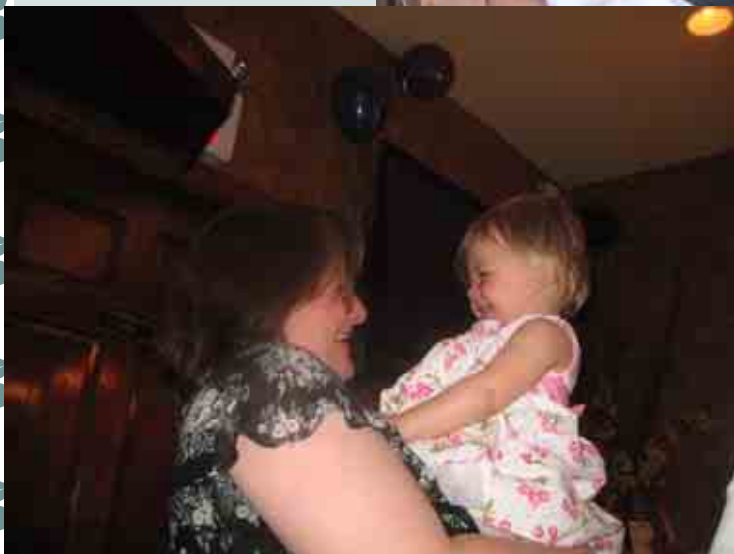
