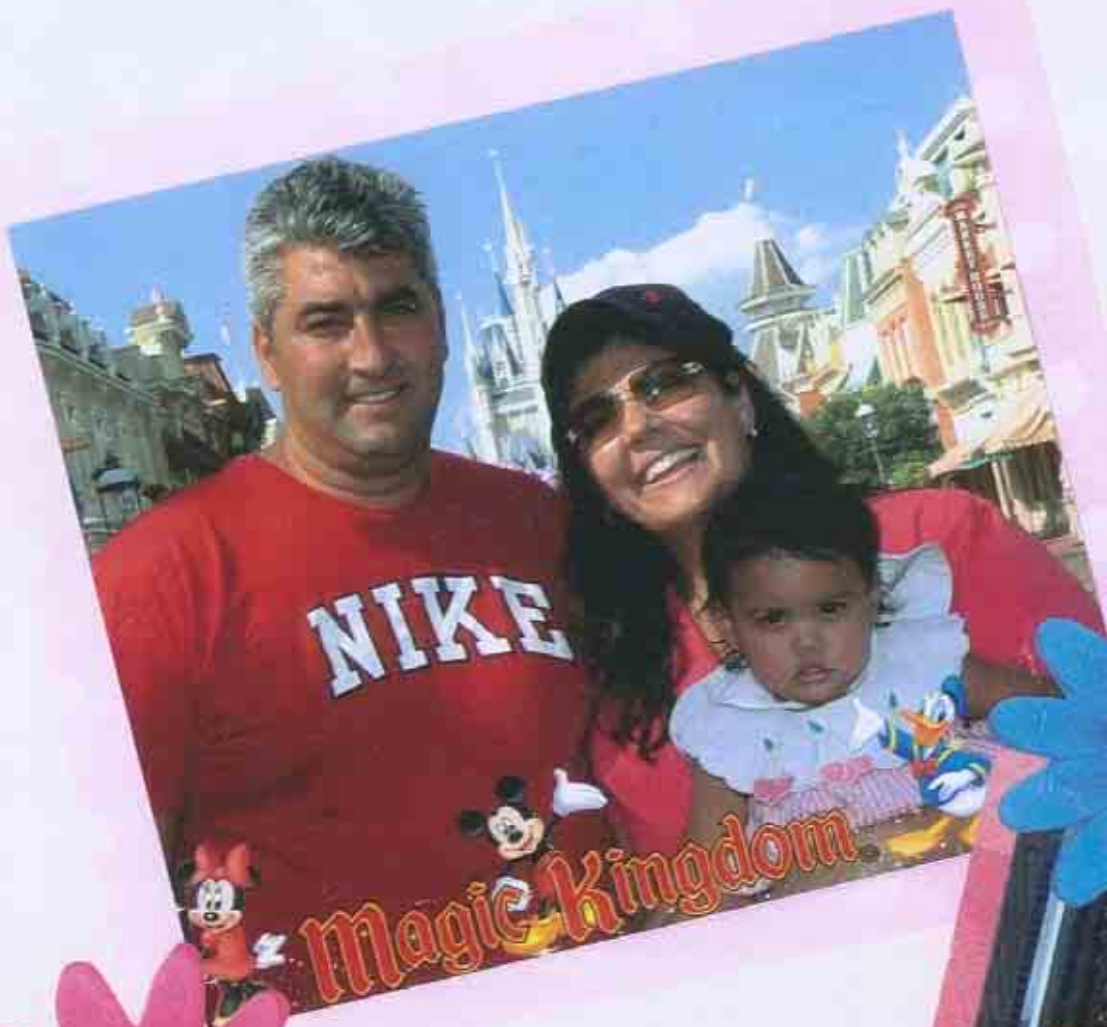


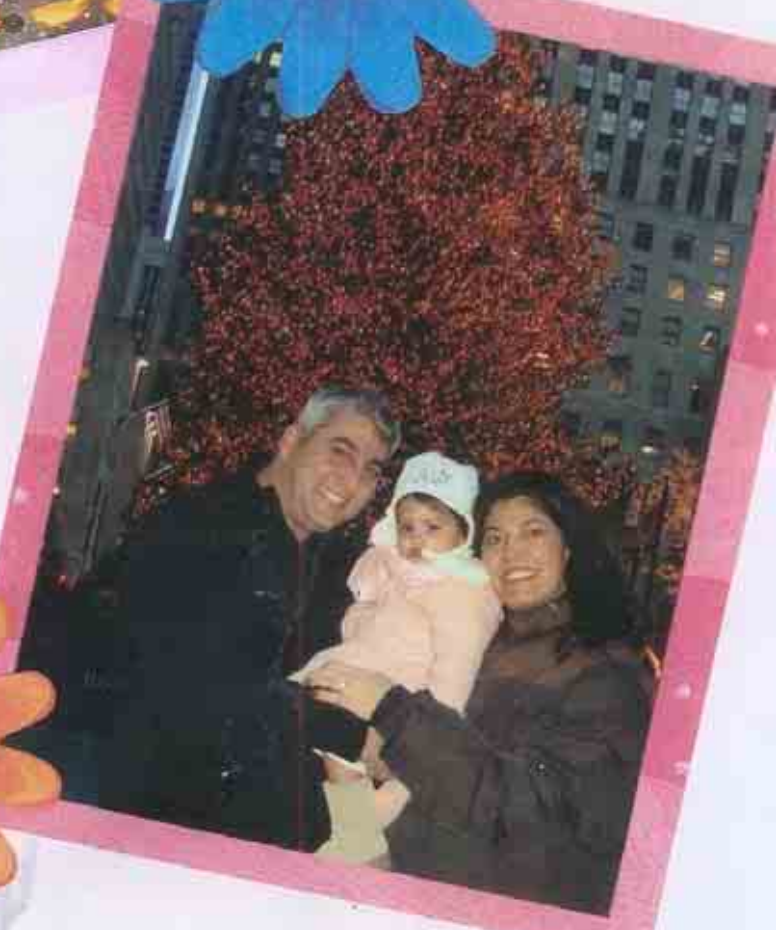

With your help, love and trust we will raise your child with total devotion and love. Please consider us to be the adoptive parents of your child.

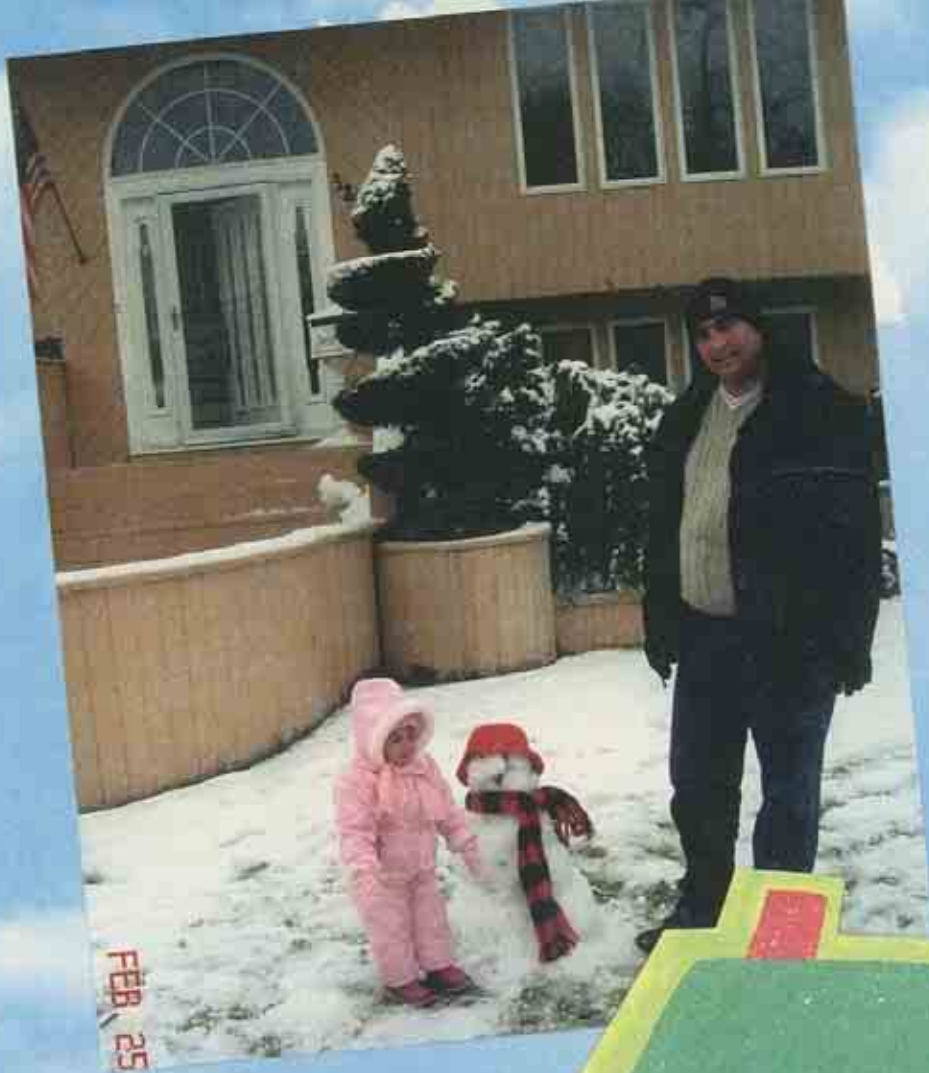
